RWE Secures 151 Megawatts at French Regulatory Energy Commission Latest Bidding Round

- Amongst the 7 awarded projects, 5 are fully owned by RWE, one is co-developed with Vent du Nord and another one with Escofi.
- This result positions RWE as the top awardee in the latest auction, ahead of 22 other selected companies.
- This new success, following the two projects awarded during the most recent solar auctions, further strengthens RWE's position as a leading player in the French market.

The French Energy Regulatory Commission (CRE) has just published the results of the latest onshore wind bidding round for a total capacity of 930 megawatts (MW) at an average price of €87.61/MWh. Seven projects have been awarded to RWE, representing a prorated capacity of 151 MW and a total capacity of 183 MW. Among these projects, five are fully owned by RWE, while two are being co-developed—one with Vent du Nord and the other with Escofi.

A diversified portfolio

The seven awarded projects will add 35 wind turbines across four regions in France—Centre-Val de Loire, Grand Est, Hauts-de-France, and Normandy—further enhancing the geographical diversity of RWE's development pipeline. The first turbines could be commissioned as early as 2027, with additional installations expected through 2028.
